



Electric Hot Tub Fact Sheet

Both hot tubs are in private locations

We now also have an electric hot tub that is situated just by the lake. This is the kind that bubbles. It does need regular checks of the water to check the pH and clarity. The water is tested and changed on a regular basis.

- The usual cost is between £40 (short break) and £60 (for a week) for the electric hot tub only (not for both tubs)
- In extreme weather i.e. freezing temperatures a £5 surcharge may be added.
- If you wish to have a fresh batch of water for your tub there is an additional cost of approximately £30. This is on top of the usual cost of between £40/60 (short break or a week) which is for the upkeep of the tub and the provision of chemicals and electricity charges.
- Note if you wish to have a water change, this means that the hot tub will not be ready straight away on your arrival as it takes up to 24 hours to bring the water up to temperature on a cold day.
- If you do wish to have a water change we will need plenty of warning for this (e.g. a week) so that we can refill and reheat the tub.
- The commercial recommendation is to change the water every 2 months as the chemicals purify and clarify the water along with the filters that are changed and cleaned weekly.
- This tub is easy to use and means that you do not have to light a fire as with the wood burning hot tub. It is easy to regulate the temperature.
- Please do not wear fake tan when going into the tub.
- No smoking in the tub.
- Additional information about the use of the hot tub is on a sign at Water's Edge.
- Care must be taken when removing the hot tub lid. The handles must be used. Do not leave the lid on the floor and replace the lid when not in use.
- If the water is spoiled by the addition of food or alcohol then a charge may be taken out of your deposit. Please do not go in the lake! Then go into the hot tub etc. and please don't wear wet suits in the hot tub.

DEPOSIT – please note that a £100 returnable deposit is required for the hot tub and the boats (to cover potential losses of paddles/ damage etc.) Deposit is only acceptable in CASH. Use of the equipment is not allowed until a deposit is paid.

If a party is made up of under 25s, then a returnable security deposit can be higher (up to £250)



Health Warning!

DO NOT USE IF PREGNANT

If you use the tub you do so at your own risk and the owners cannot accept any responsibility for health problems that result from its use

Hot water can affect your heart rate

Hot water can affect your sperm count!!!

Do not use if pregnant or if you have any heart problems

Do not stay in the tub for more than 20 minutes – take a break after this time

Avoid the consumption of alcohol when using the tub

The golden rule is to always keep the water level to the designated mark to avoid any damage to the stove

Please note that in extreme weather conditions (e.g. freezing conditions) it is sometimes not possible to fill and empty the hot tub due to frozen pipes. This is a rare occurrence. There may be an extra cost in heating the hot tub in extremely cold weather.

Please note that the provision of logs, sticks and kindling is a time consuming and arduous procedure along with the costs of purchasing these e.g. £50 per builders sack of logs. Hence we have to charge for this provision accordingly – we do not make any profit from the provision of logs and wood. It is quite possible if using the hot tub snorkel stove and the wood burner continuously to use up to £130 of wood in winter a week. Please bear this in mind when considering the overall cost.
